Part I – Public Session

111. To accept Apologies for Absence (*agenda item 1*).

Apologies for absence were received from Cllr Graham Hawes, Cllr Mrs Annie Norgrove arrived at 6.34 P.M.

112. To receive Declarations of Interest (*agenda item 2*).

There were no declarations of Interest to report.

113. Confirmation of the Minutes (*agenda item 3*).

114. Adjournment (*agenda item 4*).

115. Grants of Cemetery Rights (*agenda item 5*).

Authority was given for the issue of Grants of Exclusive Rights in respect of burial as indicated in Agenda Appendix A.

116. Harpers Recreation Ground – Scout Hut (*agenda item 6*).

Members considered Ash Parish Council acquiring the 2nd Ash Scout Hut at Harpers Road Recreation Ground following the disbanding of the Scout group. The chairman gave a report and it was:

Recommended upon consideration that Ash Parish Council take possession of the 2nd Ash Scout Hut at Harpers Road Recreation Ground.

117. Ash Cemetery (*agenda item 7*).

- a) Members considered in retrospect the purchase of hydraulic grave shoring and ground guards at a total cost of £6133.00 + VAT. Concurrent function grant agreed.
- b) Members considered the use of one row of graves in Section I (Bluebell) currently being used as an unofficial footpath.
- c) Following the price review at the Finance & Administration meeting held on 22 February 2010. Members considered the necessary amendments to the cemetery Rules & Regulations to take effect from 1 April 2010.

- b) **That the reinstatement of one row of unallocated graves in Section 1 (Bluebell) be agreed.**
- c) **That the necessary amendments to the Cemetery Rules & Regulations be agreed with effect from 1 April 2010.**

118. Gas Heating to Ash Centre Main Hall (*agenda item 8*).

Following the necessary maintenance inspection of the gas boilers. Members considered a quote tendered for the servicing of the high level gas burners at a cost of £587.00 + VAT and it was:
