DURING THE POLICE ADJOURNMENT THE FOLLOWING REPORT WAS GIVEN BY PCSO NICOLA CARR.

- Two burglaries in local area.
- 1 motor vehicle theft – vehicle recovered.
- Four incidents of criminal damage which included stone throwing in York Road and Salisbury Road area - youths caught.
- Graffiti around the Parish – two males have been apprehended.
- Theft from local shop.
- Teen shelter at Parsons Nose vandalised.
- Ash Manor School – theft of lead from roof.
- Ash Grange Primary School – youths climbing onto roof of school – youths caught.

DURING THE PUBLIC ADJOURNMENT THE FOLLOWING POINTS WERE RAISED

- Foreman Road – parking. (Marsha Moseley suggested residents attend the Lord Pirbright Hall this Wednesday 10 March 2010 as Surrey County Council Highways officers will be in attendance).
- Ash Church Road – cars for sale in layby. (To be reported to Gary Kirk at Guildford Borough Council).
- Ash Church Road – footpath from Foreman Road junction to St Peters Hall full of litter which is encouraging rats. Vegetation overgrown. Parish office to report to Guildford Borough Council – litter and Surrey County Council – vegetation.
- Land adjacent to Dean Close – fence erected around area. Public consultation starts Tuesday 9 March 2010 for three days at Guildford Borough Council.
- Land adjacent to Dean Close - stream overflowing – no other flooding problems reported around the Parish.
- River Ash stream is maintained by Environment Agency.
- Willow Tree behind Culverlands Close – contact Environment Agency.
- Grange Farm Road – in bad disrepair. Contact Surrey County Council
- Outside 35 Ashborne Close – rain gullies crumbling
- Longacre Estate – footpath littered. Lesley Telford Gillies has reported.
