The first Ash Parish Council Village Fete took place on Saturday 18 June 2016 (this replaced the Ash Fun Day format). The Parade was led by the Chairman of the Council, Nigel Manning and Member of Parliament for Surrey Heath, the Rt Hon Michael Gove. The Service of Remembrance was conducted by members of the local clergy and a number of service personnel, including members of the Royal British Legion and other uniformed organisations took part in the wreath laying ceremony. Once again attendance at this Parade was extremely high and it was wonderful to see age groups across generations taking part and paying respects to those who had served their country during times of conflict.

For the seventh year in a row Ash Parish Council ran its own Ash in Bloom competition and once again there were many amazing entries, certainly the keen gardeners within the Parish had gone to great lengths with their floral displays.
