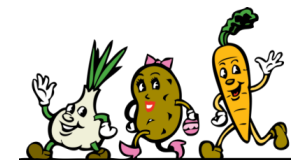
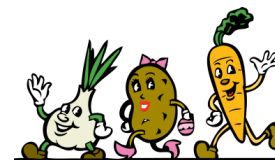

### Fete Show Schedule

### 14 July 2018 - SHOW REGULATIONS

1. All food should be covered with a food safe wrapping.
2. All exhibits must be grown / produced by the exhibitor,
3. Vases and plates will be provided, where appropriate.
4. Floral arrangements shall not contain silk or artificial flowers, unless specified.
5. Exhibits must be staged between 10:00 am and noon on the morning of the event.
6. With the exception of the Judge's, the Show Organiser and his/her accredited assistants the hall will be closed to all other persons from noon until 1:00pm.
7. The Judge's decision shall be final.
8. All exhibits must be removed by the exhibitors at the end of the show.
9. Ash Parish Council will not be held responsible for compensation regarding loss or damage, from any cause, in respect of exhibits or personal property.
10. Winners' Certificates will be awarded at a special Ash in Bloom 2018 presentation evening to be held in September and winners are advised that any photograph taken may be used in any Ash Parish Council publicity material.



## Ash in Bloom 2018



### Section 1 - Flowers

Class 1	Lilies	3 stems.
Class 2	Pinks	3 stems.
Class 3	Cut Flowers	9 stems of mixed garden flowers.

### Section 2 - Fruit and Vegetables

Class 4	A Collection of Vegetables	Three kinds, two of each kind.
Class 5	Carrots	3 with tops attached.
Class 6	Tomatoes	4 of the same type.
Class 7	Soft Mixed Fruit	A dish of mixed fruits.
Class 8	Chilli	A pot grown edible chilli. (max size 8"/20cm).
Class 9	Rhubarb	3 sticks - without foliage.
Class 10	Bouquet Garni	Mixed herbs, hand tied.

### Section 3 - Flower Arranging

Class 11	11th Hour - Peace at Last 1918	Accessories may be used. (max diameter 24"/61cms)
Class 12	The Colours of the Rainbow	Mixed Flowers. (max diameter 18"/46cm)
Class 13	Each Little Flower That Opens	A petite exhibit. (max diameter 6"/15cm)

**NB: The classes will be staged on a table with a white cover.**

### Section 4 - Craft

Class 14	A hand knitted or crocheted garment for a baby or child.
Class 15	A tote bag made from recycled material.
Class 16	A photograph entitled "Sunset". Photo size 6ins x 4ins/15cm x 10cms max. To be taken during the last twelve months.
