



## FORESTRY WORKS – Winter 2019

### South East MOD Training Areas

#### Forestry Thinning works within the adjacent Training Area.

Various compartments will be selectively thinned – meaning we will remove some of the smaller and poorer quality trees allowing those remaining more space and light to grow, as well as opening up the tree canopy to allow more light to reach the forest floor, encouraging the growth of woodland plants. Thinning works will take place during winter and during this time, we ask for your co-operation to observe and adhere to the warning signs and barriers that will be installed.

- **Access through work sites is prohibited – for your own safety, please adhere to all safety signs and do not cross tape barriers. Do not climb on timber stacks.**
- **Please keep your dogs on leads and supervise children at all times.**
- **Please do not approach working machinery or moving lorries and vehicles.**
- **Please do not park on the approach roads or next to the barriers, as timber Lorries and emergency vehicles require access 24/7.**

**On completion the signs and tapes will be removed. Then reinstatement works will commence including track works and brash removal if required.**

These works are being undertaken through the Defence Infrastructure Organisation's Forestry Management Plan, which is drawn up with the approval and consent of Natural England and the Forestry Commission.
