

Act on Scams

A scam is a scheme to try to steal money, personal information or data from a person or organisation. Other names for a scam include fraud, hoax, con, swindle and cheat.

Citizens Advice are encouraging people to play their part in preventing scams by reporting and talking about them.

Only about 13% of all scams are currently reported. That's a huge number of scams that aren't known about, and therefore cannot be prevented.
