Activities Hub

Our aim is to encourage everyone to enjoy a healthy and rewarding life that makes living longer a real cause for celebration. If you are looking to make new friends in a relaxed setting, learn new things and enjoy a happy, social day out, then our Activities Hub is for you!



When you attend and how long for is entirely up to you. If you wish to stay for the whole day, a 2



course lunch can be ordered for £4.60 for members or £6.40 for non-members.

To attend the Activities Hub, you will need to complete our registration form. Membership is charged annually at £13.50. To find out more, please contact us.

Community Meals

This service provides hot nutritional meals to residents across the borough.

We can be flexible to suit your needs and you don't have to use us 7 days a week, although this is an option. You chose a main course and dessert, that will be delivered to you between 11.30am and 2pm. The cost is £4.50 for the two courses.



The criteria for our Community Meals are that the person is:



- Unable to cook for themselves
- Not motivated to cook
- Need prompting to eat regular meals.
- Unable to shop
- A carer who could be assisted by meal preparation.

Community Transport

This service provides transport for eligible residents to access a range of activities including:



- Transport to The Hive
- Shopping
- Social activities and trips
- Visiting friends and family
- Attending hospital or medical appointments

All our buses are fully accessible for anyone with some form of disability or mobility issue.

The service is available to anyone who:




- Has a physical disability or mobility issues
- Has long or short-term ill health
- Has learning difficulties
- Has mental health issues


You will need to register for Community Transport, this costs £13.50 per year to join plus a per mile fee when you travel. For more information, please contact us.
