Purpose

All major emergencies will be dealt with by the emergency services, local authorities, utilities and voluntary agencies. The Emergency Plan is not intended to be a substitute for these services and, in the event of an emergency the first course of action should always be to contact the emergency services by **dialling 999**.

The purpose of the Ash Parish Council Emergency Plan is to cover extreme circumstances, (for example, heavy snowfall or flooding) that may prevent the emergency services from reaching the scene immediately. In such cases the initial response may rely on the residents of the Parish.

The Emergency Plan sets out how an initial response will be co-ordinated.

Appendix A includes emergency contact numbers for use as required.

Initial Response Actions

If an emergency arises and it is not possible for the emergency services to respond straight away, or it is not possible to contact the emergency services, the Ash Emergency Plan should be initiated:

In the event of the Chairman being unavailable, a key holding Officer will be contacted from the list supplied to the Emergency Co-ordinator and the Deputy Co-ordinator.
